“SDB has put in place multi-tier safety measures, including the encrypted biometric identification system in use in the MyKad, to ensure that only the rightful clients have access to the safe deposit boxes. “The locations chosen by SDB have been carefully selected for safety and convenience, at the same time pre-empting likely attacks by undesirable persons,” SDB chairman Tan Sri Mohd Jamil Johari said. Other safety features include fingerprint scan,

seismic alarms, motion and audio sensors, dual control locking mechanism and CCTV cameras for off-site surveillance and monitoring. SDB invited Selangor police chief Deputy Commissioner Datuk Khalid Abu Bakar recently to visit its premises at The Summit USJ to provide his professional views and comments.

The branch operates seven days a week, from 10am to 7pm, except on public holidays. The other SDB outlets are at Metropolitan Square in Damansara Perdana and Menara MPL at Jalan Raja Chulan, Kuala Lumpur. For details, visit <http://www.safedepositbox.com.my/>.
